

Acetaminophen Dosing Chart

Acetaminophen reduces fever and relieves pain. Typical uses include fever reduction, teething, earaches, bruises, headaches and may be given prior to vaccinations.

- *Tylenol should **not** be used for babies **under 2 months** of age without Pediatrician approval.*
- **Acetaminophen** is available in the following forms and may be dosed **every 4-6 hours**.
 - Children's Liquid (160mg/5ml)
 - Chewable tablets (80mg)
 - Junior Strength tablets (160mg)

**Note: 1 Dropper = 0.8 ml
1 tsp = 5 ml**
